The above petition has been approved. We have sent it to the **Department of State National Visa Center (NVC), 32 Rochester Avenue, Portsmouth, NH 03801-2909**. NVC processes all approved immigrant visa petitions that need consular action. It also determines which consular post is the appropriate consulate to complete visa processing. The NVC will then forward the petition to the appropriate consulate to have visa issued.

This completes all USCIS action on the petition. You should allow approximately 30 days for Department of State processing before contacting the NVC. You will need to enter the USCIS receipt number from this approval notice in the subject line. In order to receive information about your petition, you will need to include the Petitioner's name and date of birth, and the Applicant's name and date of birth, in the body of the e-mail.

The NVC will contact the person for whom you are petitioning concerning further immigrant visa processing steps.

The approval of this visa petition does not in itself grant any immigration status and does not guarantee that the alien beneficiary will subsequently be found eligible for a visa, or admission to the United States, or for an extension, change, or adjustment of status.
