What the Official Notice Said

The above petition has been approved. The petition indicates that the person for whom you are petitioning is in the United States and will apply for adjustment of status. Because the person for whom you are petitioning is not eligible to adjust, we have sent the approved petition to the Department of State National Visa Center (NVC), 32 Rochester Avenue, Portsmouth, NH 03801-2909. The NVC processes all approved immigrant visa petitions that need consular action and also determines which consular post (i.e., appropriate consulate) to complete visa processing. The NVC will then forward the approved petition to that consulate.

This completes all USCIS action on this petition. You should allow a minimum of 30 days for Department of State processing before contacting the NVC. If you have not received any correspondence from the NVC within 30 days, you may contact the NVC by e-mail at NVCINQUIRY@state.gov. You will need to enter the USCIS receipt number from the approval notice in the subject line in order to receive information about your petition. You will need to include the Petitioner's name and date of birth, and the Applicant's name and date of birth in the body of the e-mail.

The NVC will contact the person for whom you are petitioning concerning further immigrant visa processing steps.

The approval of this visa petition does not in itself grant any immigration status and does not guarantee that the alien beneficiary will subsequently be found to be eligible for a visa, for admission to the United States, or for an extension, change, or adjustment of status.
