What the Official Notice Said

The above petition for an NATIONAL INTEREST WAIVER-PHYSICIAN (NIW PHYSICIAN) has been approved. We have sent it to the Department of State National Visa Center (NVC). NVC processes all approved immigrant visa petitions that need consular action. It also determines which consular post is the appropriate consulate to complete visa processing. The NVC will then forward the approved petition to that consulate. This completes all USCIS action on this petition. You should allow a minimum of 90 days for Department of State processing before contacting the NVC. If you have not received any correspondence from the NVC within 90 days, you may contact the NVC by using Public Inquiry Form at <https://nvc.state.gov/inquiry>.

Pursuant to Section 203(b)(2) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), the beneficiary is not eligible for issuance of an immigrant visa until he/she completes 3 or 5 (whichever is applicable) years of employment in an underserved area. The NVC will contact the beneficiary for information concerning future immigrant visa processing steps.
